

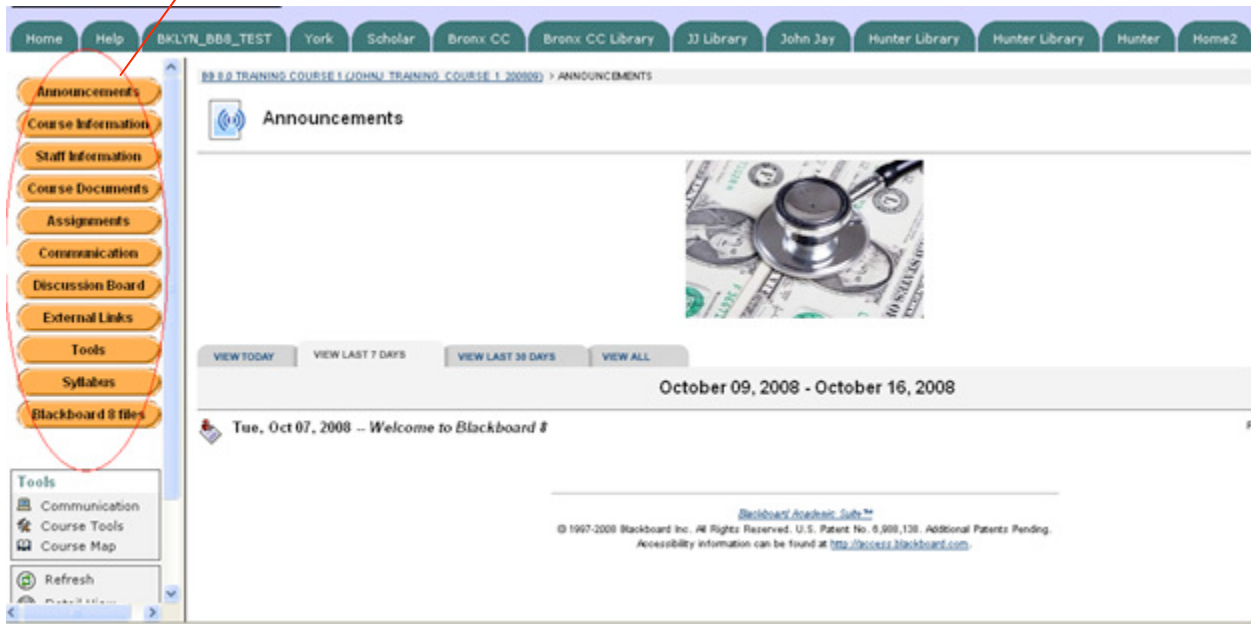
# BLACKBOARD 8.0

After you have successfully logged in, you will find your courses under “My Courses.” You can select the course you wish to see.


# BLACKBOARD 8.0


# BLACKBOARD 8.0

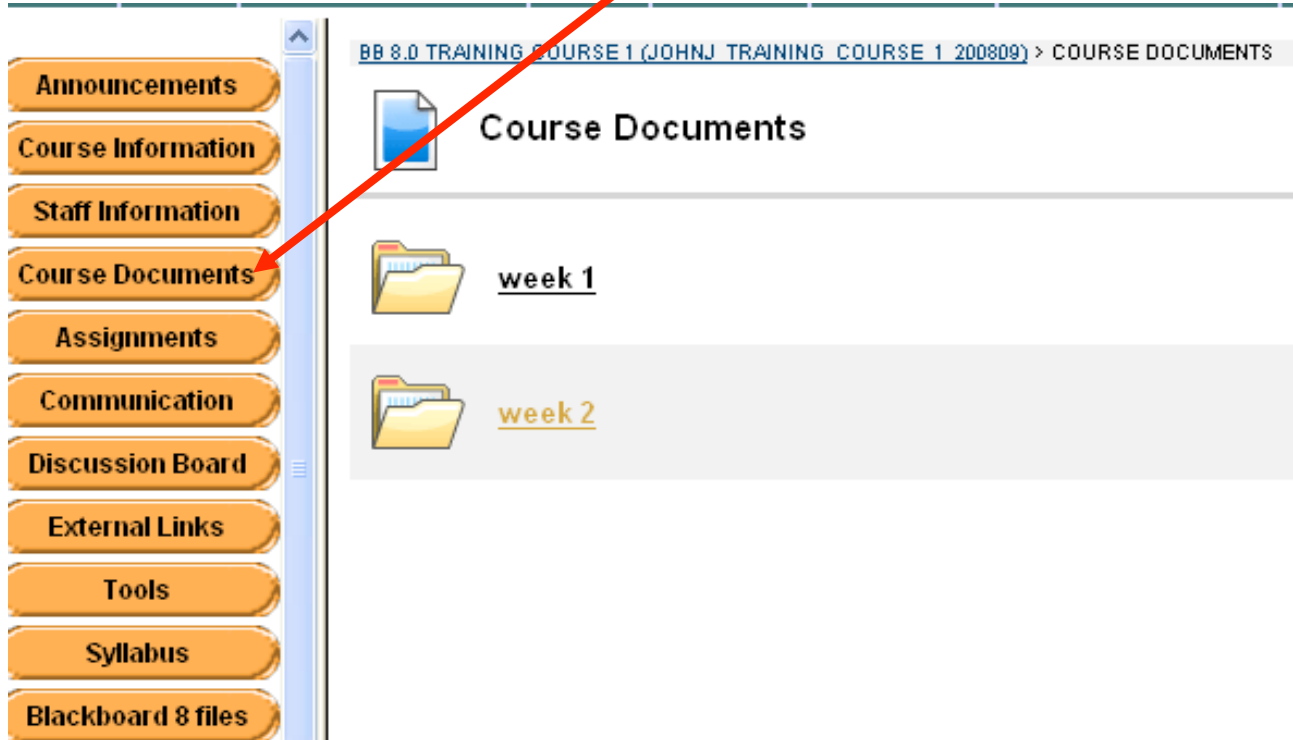

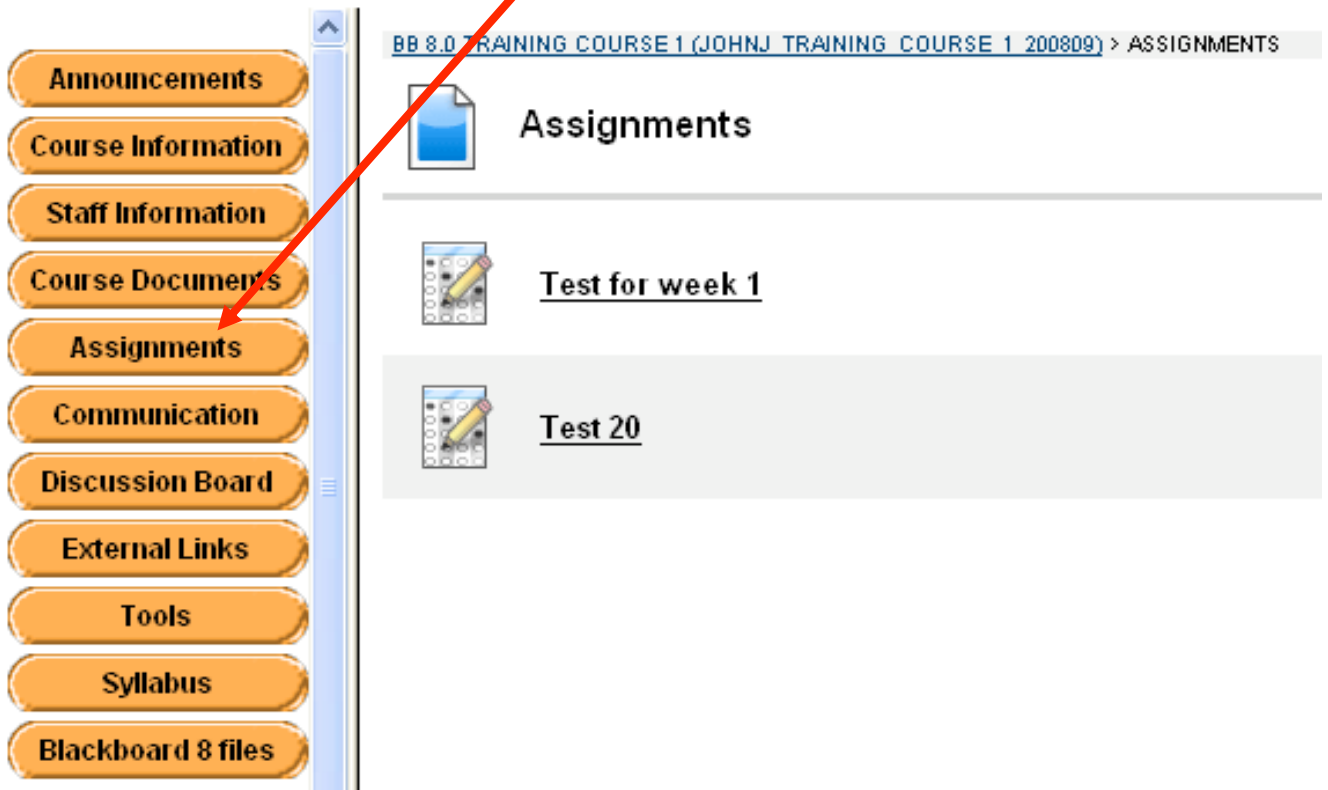
To view documents and/or folders that your professor/instructor may have posted, you must click on “Course Documents.”

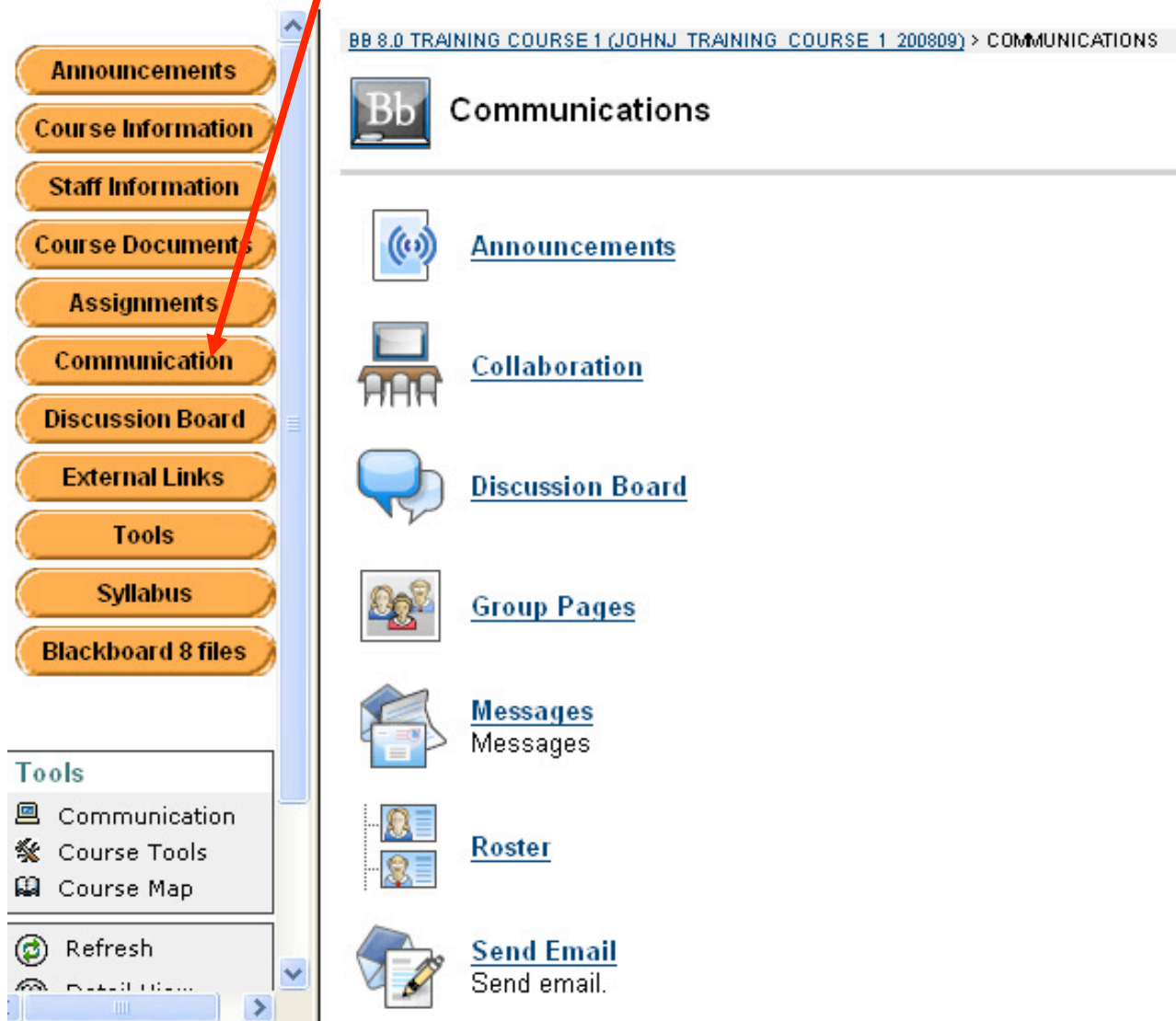

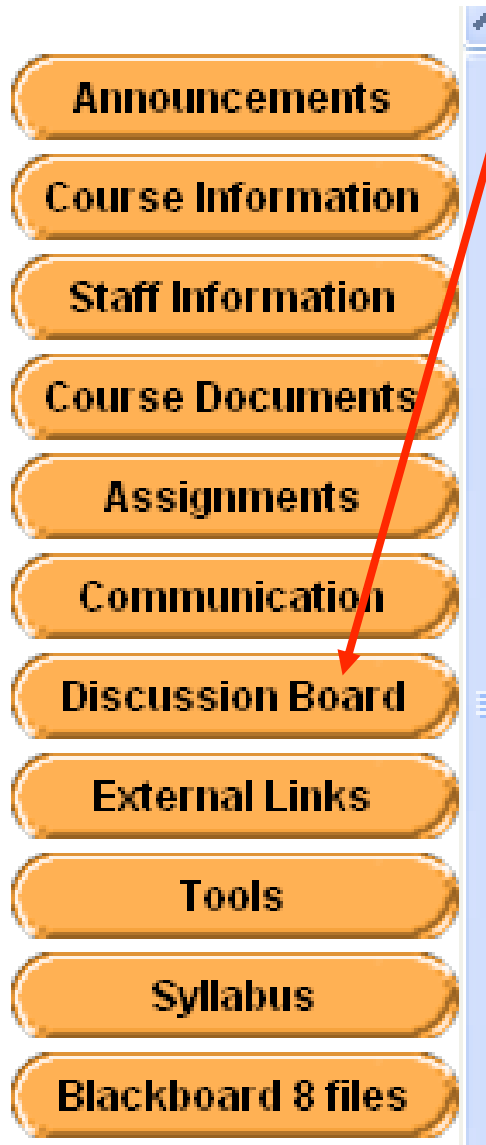
By selecting the “Communication” option you can execute various tasks, such as checking your “Announcements” and “Send Email.”

The “Discussion Board” is where you can interact with your professor and/or classmates. You can post discussion items and reply to your classmates’ or professor’s posts. This is very similar to Chat, but users do not have to be online at the same time to communicate. Click on the “Discussion Board” tab on the navigational unit to access these features.

An alternative way to access the “Discussion Board” is to click on the “Communication” option and then” Discussion Board.”

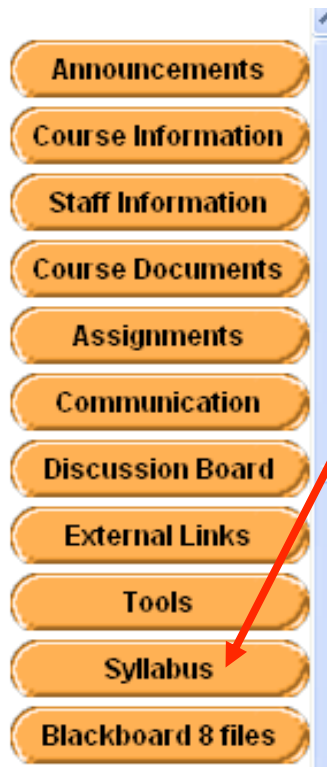

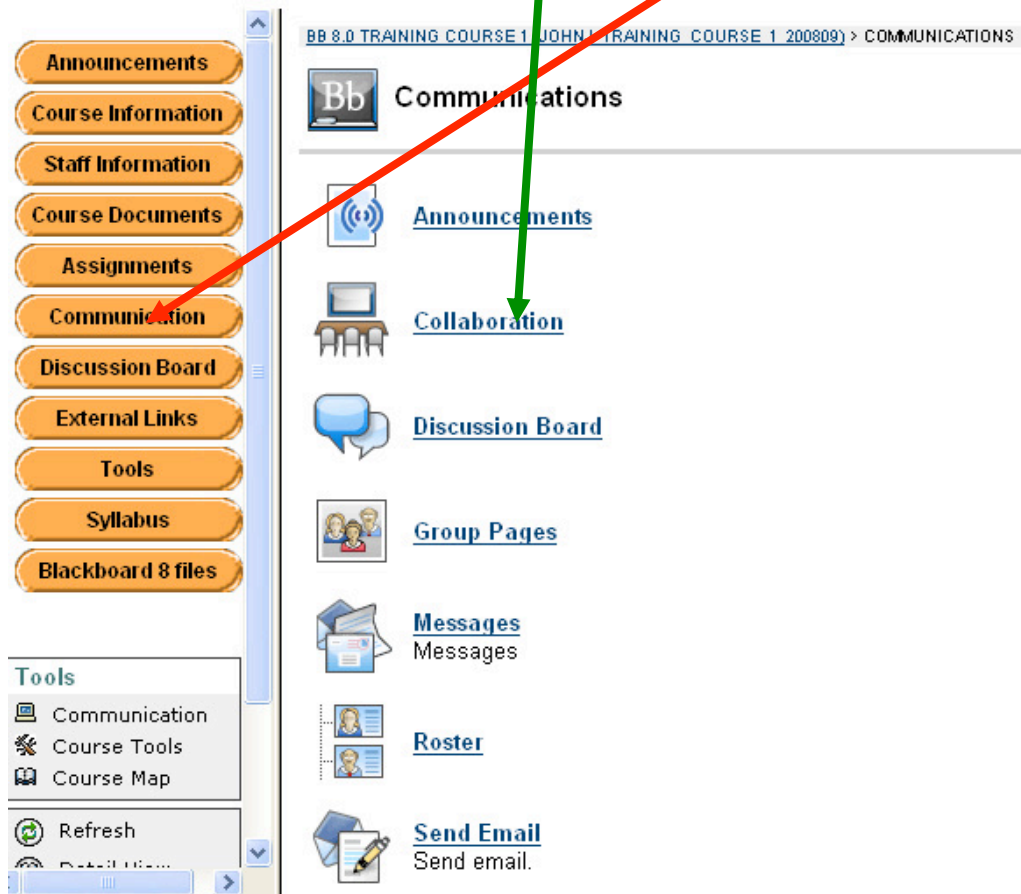
# BLACKBOARD 8.0

The “Announcements” home page specific to the class will appear once again if you click on “Announcements.” By default, “Announcements” will be the main entry point of any course.

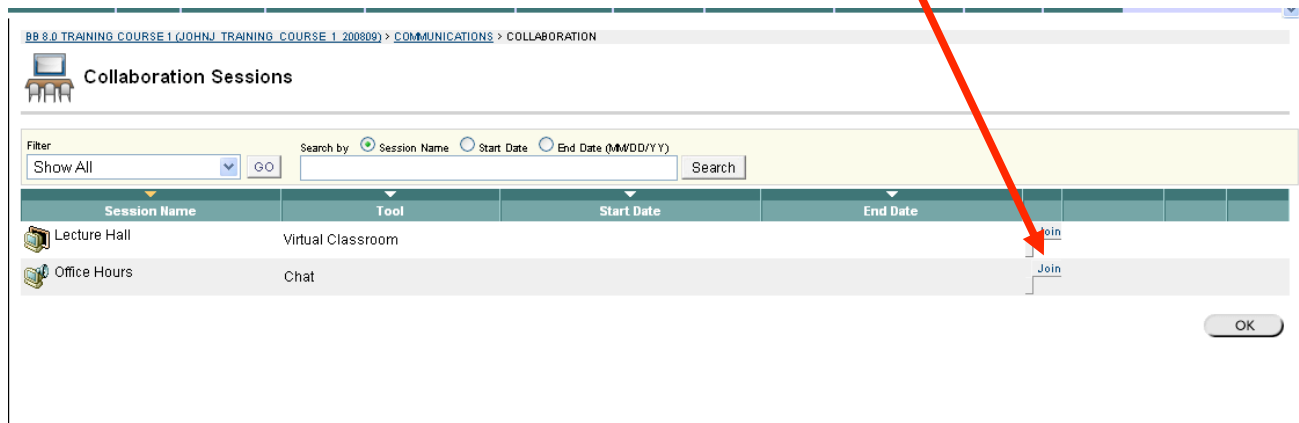

The collaboration session will appear if you click on “Communication” followed by “Collaboration.”

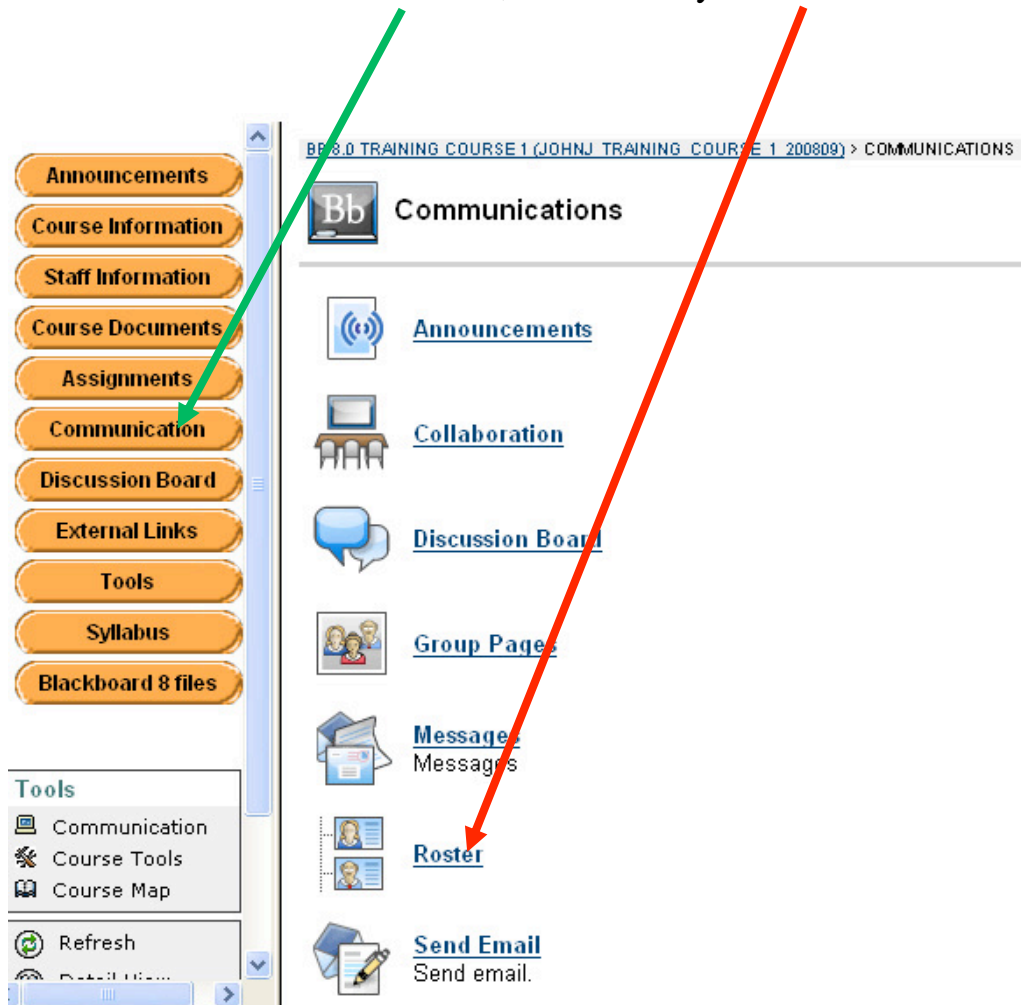


Then join a discussion by clicking “Join.”
