<p>Transferring from a CUNY or non-CUNY community college with an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Science (A.S) degree.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Required Core & Flexible Core are complete • 6 credits (2 courses) in the College Option are still required: a 300 level Justice course chosen from <i>Struggles for Justice & Equality in the U.S.</i> OR <i>Justice in Global Perspectives</i> and a <i>Learning from the Past</i> course OR a <i>Communications</i> course.
<p>Transferring from a CUNY or non-CUNY community college with an Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S) degree.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • John Jay’s Office of Testing & Evaluation will determine which of your courses meet the Required Core & Flexible Core requirements. You will need to complete all parts of those areas not satisfied. • 6 credits (2 courses) in the College Option are still required: a 300 level Justice course chosen from <i>Struggles for Justice & Equality in the U.S.</i> OR <i>Justice in Global Perspectives</i> and a <i>Learning from the Past</i> course OR a <i>Communications</i> course.
<p>Transferring from a CUNY or non-CUNY community college student with credits but no degree.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • John Jay’s office of Testing & Evaluation will determine which of your transfer credits meet the Required Core & Flexible Core. You will need to complete all parts of those areas not satisfied. • 31 or more transfer credits: 9 College Option credits that include a <i>Learning from the Past</i> course, a <i>Communications</i> course, & a 300 level Justice course from <i>Struggles for Justice & Equality in the U.S.</i> OR <i>Justice in Global Perspective</i>. • 30 or less transfer credits: All 12 credits of the College Option are required.
<p>Transferring from a CUNY or non-CUNY four year college Bachelor’s degree program with credits but <u>no degree</u>.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • John Jay’s Office of Testing & Evaluation will determine which Required Core, Flexible Core & College Option requirements you have met. <p><u>College Option:</u></p> <p><u>CUNY Credits:</u> 12 College Option Credits are required. College Option credits completed at another CUNY college will be honored and applied towards JJAY’s College Option Requirements.</p> <p><u>Non-CUNY Credits:</u> 12 College Option credits are required but some transfer credits may be applied here.</p>
<p>Transferring from a CUNY or non-CUNY with a Bachelor’s degree for a second undergraduate Bachelor’s degree at John Jay.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Gen Ed requirements are complete except for required prerequisites for your major. • Required to earn at least 30 credits in residency, complete your major, & a minimum of 2.0 GPA.
